

Dispose of ceramics, glasses cosmetic bottles, and broken bottles as non-burnable waste.



#### What Is Included in Bulk Wastes?

In principle, whatever cannot fit into a designated bag is bulk waste. If broken into pieces small enough to fit into designated bags, items can be disposed of as burnable or non-burnable wastes.

#### **Bulk Waste Collection**

1. Collected by the Village Office:

BY APPOINTMENT ONLY; submit desired collection date when purchasing a bulk waste disposal ticket at the Onna Village Residents Division or at your local community hall. Put out the waste with the ticket affixed in front of your house (or apartment building) on the reserved date.

2. Personally Transport to Landfill Site (Charge applies):
