



Modulus of Families of Lipschitz Chains with Arbitrary Dimension and Codimension

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Recently, Lohvansuu (2023) introduced the p -modulus for families of k -dimensional Lipschitz chains and their dual families of $(n-k)$ -dimensional chains. While he established an upper bound for the duality of these families on Lipschitz cubes, the corresponding lower bound remained an open question. Subsequently, Kangasniemi and Prywes (2025) developed $d\text{Mod}$, a related notion of modulus based on differential forms, and successfully established a full duality result. In this talk, I will explore the implications of these developments and discuss related open problems.
