How to Book a Bicycle



1. Please contact tsvp@oist.jp to check availability.
2. Kindly review the [Bike-Use Agreement](#) and send an email confirming your agreement.
3. Once your booking is confirmed, please come to the **TSVP Office (L5EF03)** to collect the items.
4. Please find your assigned bicycle in the designated storage area.

Items Provided

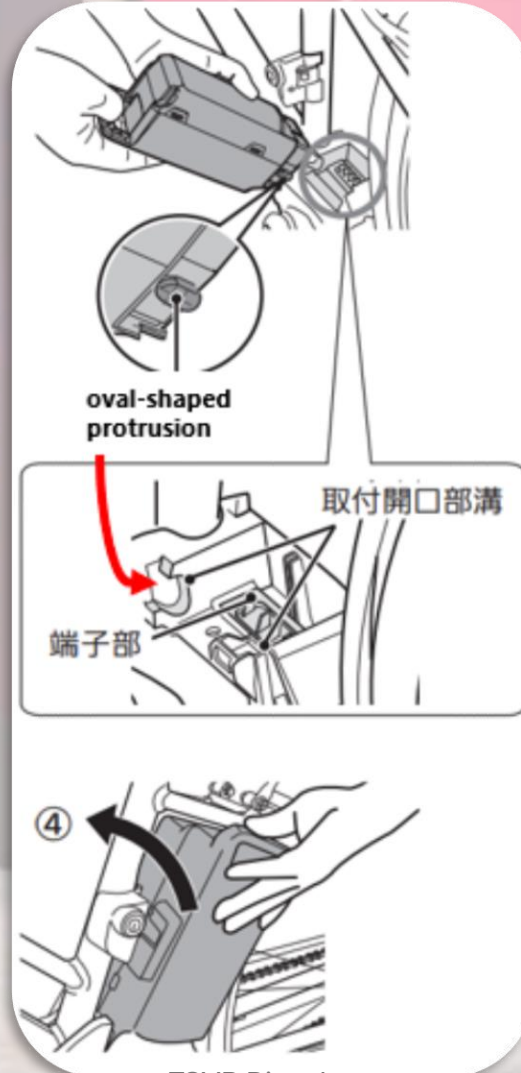
Inside the bag, you will find:

- Bicycle key
- Battery
- Battery charger

The following items are also available in the office: (Feel free to use them.)

- Helmet
- Pump
- Chain lubricant

How to use the bicycle



1. Use the key to unlock the bicycle and **attach the battery gently.**

Tilt the battery toward you and align the groove of the installation opening with the oval-shaped protrusion on the battery.

How to use the bicycle



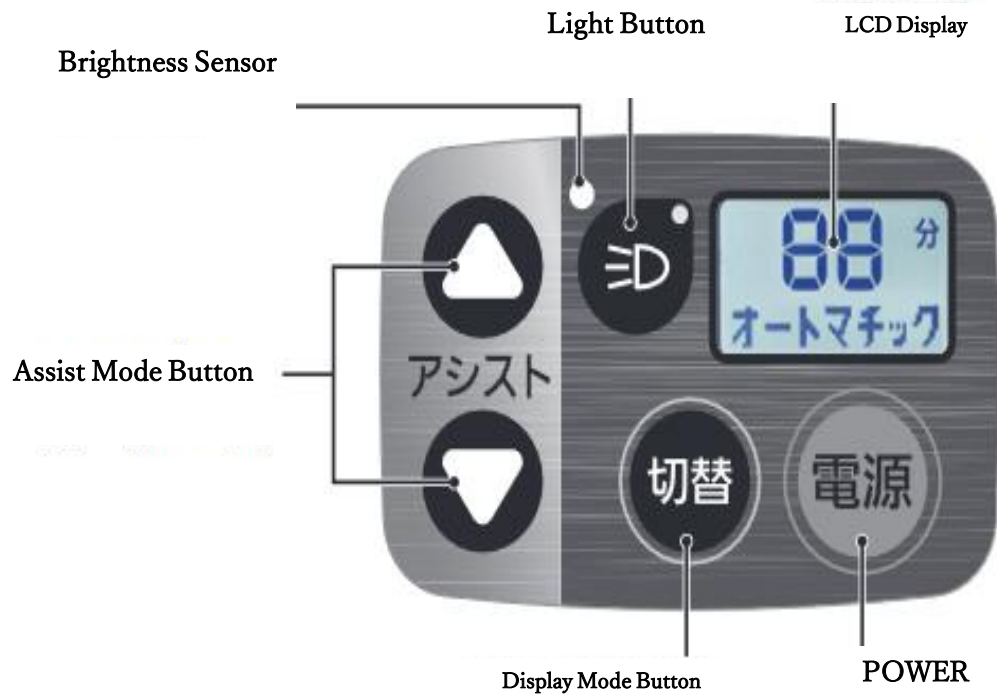
2. Use the same key to unlock the rear wheel. The key will remain in the lock unless the wheel is locked again.
3. Press the power switch before starting to ride.

⚠ Important

• **Never switch on the motor while cycling.**
Doing so may cause damage to the bicycle.



Panel Information



Assis Mode

「パワー」…… Power: Provides consistently strong assist power, allowing comfortable riding even on hills or when carrying heavy loads.

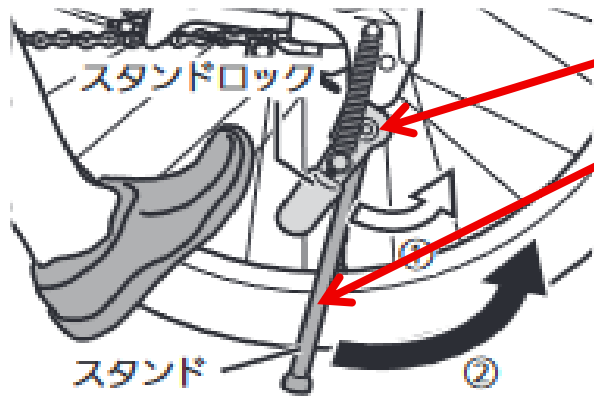
① ↑ ↓ ②

「オートマチック」…… Automatic: Automatically controls the assist power according to riding conditions.

① ↑ ↓ ②

「ロング」…… Long: Automatically controls the assist power depending on riding conditions, while further reducing assist output, enabling longer-distance riding on a single charge.

Raising the Kickstand Before Riding



- ① Press the stand lock downward with your foot to release it.
- ② Swing the kickstand completely upward toward the rear of the bicycle.

⚠ Important

Do not raise the kickstand while pressing the stand lock at the same time.
