

Public Notice of Open Competitive Bidding

Procurement will be put up for open competitive bidding as follows.

1. Procurement to be put up for open competitive bidding

(1) Purchase, etc., subject and quantity

Long pulse module power supply design 1set (offer subject to electronic bidding)

(2) Characteristics, etc., of procurement subject

With regard to performance, etc., the equipment procured must have the characteristics, etc., specified in the specifications.

(3) Delivery deadline

March 31, 2016

(4) Place of delivery

In accordance with the specifications

2. Qualifications for participation in open competitive bidding

(1) Must not fall under the provisions of Article 2 and Article 3 of the Contract Management Stipulations of the Okinawa Institute of Science and Technology School Corporation.

(2) Must not have filed a petition for commencement of rehabilitation proceedings based on the Corporate Reorganization Act, and not filed a petition for commencement of rehabilitation proceedings based on the Civil Rehabilitation Act.

(3) Must not be an entity that has received an exclusion request from the national government or police authority as an entity effectively controlled by a criminal group member or those equivalents thereto, and an entity for which such state has continued.

(4) Must be in good financial condition. To prove this, the participant must submit a copy of financial statements for the preceding two fiscal years to OIST and be certified by OIST.

3. Place and time of bid explanation and presentation of the contract terms

The specifications and other documents related to this matter will be issued following the date of this public notice and the explanation in question shall be omitted therewith.

6. Bidding method

(1) The total value of the bid amount must be stated.

(2) A form of breakdown of the bid amount must be submitted when submitting a bid.

(3) Because in the determination of the successful bid, the successful bid value will be set at the amount stated on the bid forms plus the amount equivalent to 8% of the successful bid amount, bidders shall state the value equivalent to 100/108 of the estimated bid amount regardless of whether they are parties subject to the payment of consumption tax, etc., or are tax-exempt parties. Fractions of less than 1 yen shall be discarded from the amount equivalent to 108/100 of the value stated on the bid forms and the successful bid will be deemed to have been made at the amount obtained after discarding the fractional amount in question.

(4) The bidder who made the effective bid with the lowest price within the range of limits of the estimated prices stipulated by OIST shall be the successful bidder.

8. Invalidity of bids

Bids submitted by parties without the qualifications for participation in open competitive bidding shown in this public notice and bids that violate the conditions related to bids shall be deemed

invalid.

9. Necessity of the preparation of a contract

A contract document shall be prepared for the conclusion of a contract.

10. Other

- (1) Details shall accord with the bid explanation documents and specifications.
- (2) Bids submitted by post or telegraphy, etc., shall not be accepted.
- (3) The reception and recognition of certificates, etc., shall be carried out using the electronic bid system. Parties for whom submission using the electronic bid system is difficult may change to a paper-based bid format only if they have obtained the approval of OIST at least 2 days prior to the performance of open competitive bidding.

Article 2

Parties that lack the abilities to conclude the concerned contracts and parties that are bankrupt and have not been rehabilitated may not be allowed to participate in the competitive bidding for sales, purchase, lease, service and other contracts.

Article 3

1. Parties to which any of the following is deemed to apply may be prohibited from participating in competitive bidding for a period of two years after the concerned acts. This also applies to those who use said parties as their representatives, managers or employees.
 - (1) Parties that have intentionally committed shoddy construction or production in the performance of a contract, or that have committed illegitimate acts concerning the quality or quantity of items.
 - (2) Parties that have obstructed the performance of fair competitive bidding or colluded to impair fair pricing or earn illicit gains.
 - (3) Parties that have hindered successful bidders from concluding contracts or hindered contractors from performing their contracts.
 - (4) Parties that have obstructed the work duties of employees implementing supervision or inspections.
 - (5) Parties that have failed to perform their contracts without just cause.
 - (6) Parties that have used other parties as representatives, managers, or employees for the performance of contracts within two years after said other parties committed any of the above-specified acts.
